The Board acknowledges the necessity for a system of computing grade point averages and class rank for secondary school students to inform students, parents/ guardians and others of their relative academic placement among their peers.

The Board authorizes a system of class rank, by percent grade average, for students in grades 9-12. All students shall be ranked together.

Class rank shall be computed by the final grade in all subjects, using a method recommended by the high school principal and approved by the Board.

Any two (2) or more students whose computed percent grade averages are identical shall be given the same rank. The rank of the student who immediately follows a tied position will be determined by the number of students preceding and not by the rank of the proceeding person.

A student's percent grade average and rank in class shall be entered on the student's record and transcripts and shall be subject to Board policy on release of student records.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop procedures for computing percent grade averages and assigning class rank to implement this policy, which shall include a statement of the methods for computation and rank assignment for those to whom a student's percent grade average and class rank are released.
