	701.1. NAMING SCHOOL DISTRICT FACILITIES
1. Purpose	The Bermudian Springs School District seeks to honor or memorialize outstanding individuals who have made substantial contributions to the School District.
2. Authority	<p>The Board believes that the naming of facilities or areas of the District is a matter of great importance, one that deserves thoughtful attention. The intent of this policy is to set forth parameters and guidelines for use by the Board for naming school facilities.</p> <p>The naming of any facility in the District must be approved by the Board.</p> <p>In all cases, the Board retains control and ownership over the named facilities. Naming rights will not convey any input or control over the content of school programs offered in the named area or facility, nor the disposition of said named area or facility.</p> <p>Once a facility has been officially named, it shall not be renamed except for compelling reasons to be determined by the Board.</p>
3. Definition	<p>For the purposes of this policy, facilities or areas within the School District are considered to fall within one (1) of the following categories:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A school district building. 2. A portion of a school district building. 3. A school district athletic field/facility. 4. Other area(s) of school district premises.

4. Delegation of Responsibility	Nominations for the naming of facilities shall come to the Board by recommendation of the Superintendent, through the Eagles Fund Foundation Board of the Bermudian Springs School District.
5. Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Facilities may be named for major contributors to the District if the prospective gift conforms to guidelines that match gift amounts with facility type and size.2. The school district may provide opportunities for the naming of facilities, which may include buildings, components of buildings, auditoriums, gymnasiums, playgrounds, athletic facilities, and classrooms.3. The term of the naming rights will vary but will not exceed the expected life of the facility or equipment.4. The Board reserves the right to refuse contributions, made with a view towards naming a facility, where that contribution is too restrictive in purpose, inconsistent with the district's stated academic purposes and priorities, or would adversely affect the school district. Any decision must be made consistent with applicable law and regulations.5. If a facility is to be named after a person, that person shall be of exemplary moral character; have made an outstanding contribution to education, humanity or community; have displayed outstanding leadership; or be a person of historical significance.6. The Board reserves the authority and has sole discretion to revoke the naming of a facility.7. Recommendations for naming a facility is made by the Superintendent through the Eagles Fund Foundation Board. Final approval will be by official Board vote.
