	713. CRIMES AGAINST DISTRICT
1. Authority	All crimes against the Bermudian Springs School District shall be prosecuted, and every attempt at securing restitution for loss or damage shall be made.
2. Definition	<b>Crimes against the district</b> shall include but not be limited to: arson, unlawful entry, burglary, damage and/or destruction of school property, malicious mischief to real or personal property, and all other crimes that hinder district operation or add to the operating costs.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	All district employees shall be expected to cooperate fully with law enforcement agencies and district efforts to prevent and/or solve crimes against the district.
	Building administrators shall be responsible for promptly investigating and properly reporting all crimes against their respective schools to the Superintendent.
	All crimes shall be reported to either local law enforcement agencies or to the Pennsylvania State Police by the respective building administrators.
4. Guidelines	Building principals or designees, in the course of their investigation, may interview students whose testimony might provide or lead to the facts of the case. When it is determined that the student interviewed is the suspect, district officials shall immediately inform the student of his/her rights. All interviews should be conducted in the presence of at least one (1) witness.
	The parents/guardians of students suspected of crimes against the district shall be notified by the Superintendent or designee prior to the placement of charges and/or discipline.
