| 1. Purpose   | <p>Citizen advisory committees can be useful in keeping the Board and administration informed with regard to community opinion and in representing the community in the study of specific school issues.</p>  |
| 2. Authority | <p>In creating an advisory committee, the Board shall define the committee assignment and shall:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Appoint residents who are interested and can make some special contribution to the committee's function.</li><li>2. Approve appointment of residents, staff members and/or students recommended by the Superintendent.</li><li>3. Appoint a chairperson.</li><li>4. Appoint the President and the Superintendent as ex-officio members of all advisory committees.</li></ol> <p>Recommendations of advisory committees shall not reduce the responsibility of the Board, which shall be free to accept or reject the recommendations.</p> <p>Meetings of an advisory committee are not regular meetings of the Board and shall be open to the public only upon invitation of the committee.</p> |
